# Show Flyer Design Workshop



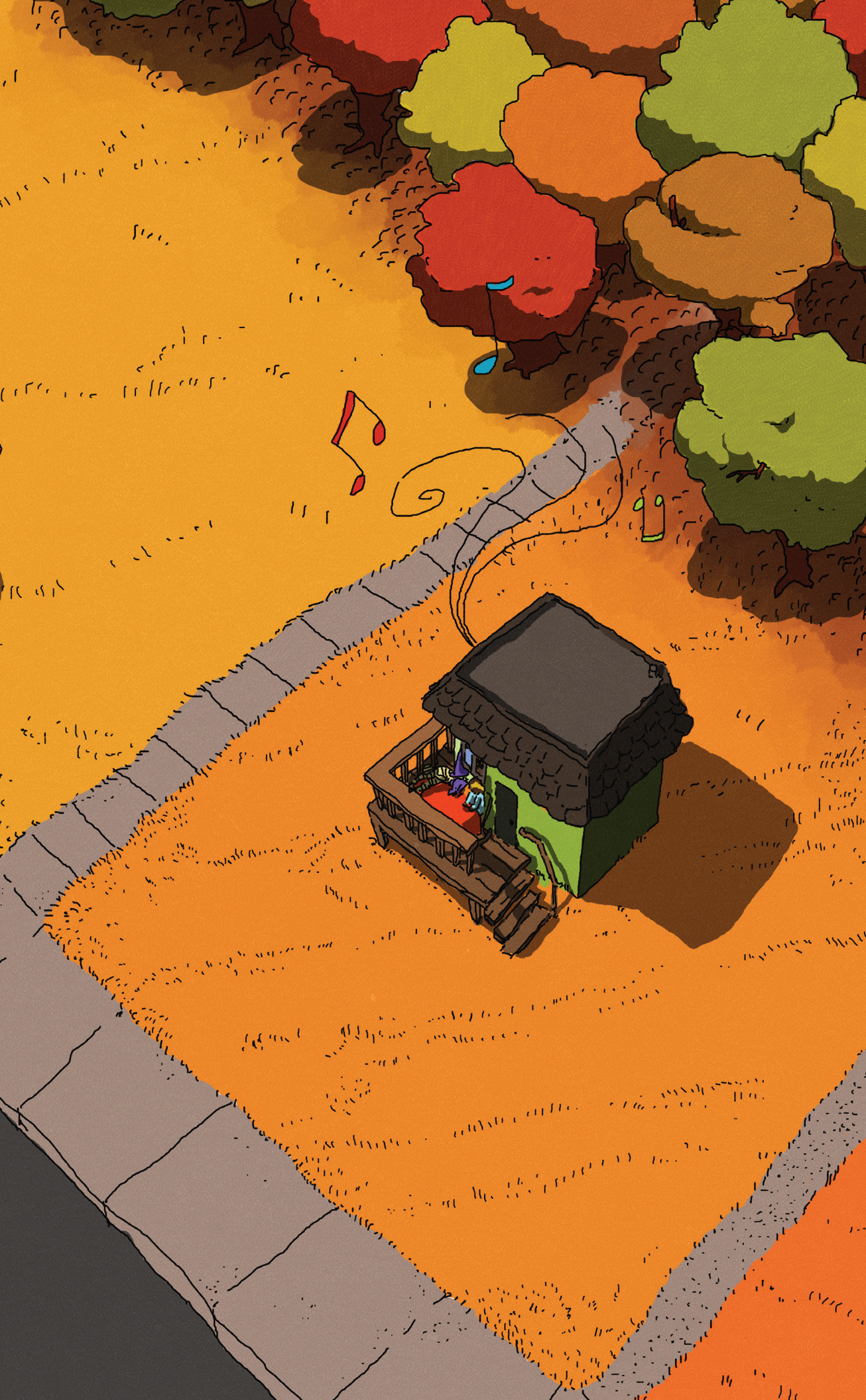
